



What is MTNT Foundation?

The MTNT Foundation was established as a separate non-profit charitable organization by MTNT, Limited. MTNT Foundation strives to support our shareholders and their descendants by providing post-secondary scholarships for higher education and other learning programs. We believe higher education can improve our standard of living and provide economic opportunities while honoring our cultural values and subsistence lifestyles.

Who can Apply for MTNT Foundation Scholarships?

To be eligible for MTNT Foundation scholarships, applicants must:

- Be an MTNT Shareholder or a descendant of an original Shareholder. ***If not a Shareholder*** of MTNT Limited, submit a ***copy of your birth certificate*** as proof of your relationship to an original MTNT Shareholder (first time applicants).
- Be accepted to an accredited college, university, technical or vocational school.
- Be enrolled in a program that is at least six weeks or 120 hours long
- Maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 for undergraduate students, 3.0 for graduate or master's degree students, or 3.25 for specialists or doctorate students

If a new student applies with a GPA below these criteria, the student will be placed on probation for the first funding period. If a returning student's GPA falls below these criteria during any funding period, the student will be placed on probation. If the student fails to increase his/her cumulative GPA to the minimum level during the probation period, sequential funding will be canceled, and the student must successfully complete a semester on his/her own before reapplying for funding.

What kind of scholarships does MTNT Foundation offer and when do I apply?

MTNT Foundation offers basic and vocational scholarships. Awards range from \$500 per semester for part-time students to \$1,000.00 per semester for full-time.

Basic Scholarships

Basic scholarships are for students enrolled in a degree program, at an accredited school, either part time or full time. There are three deadlines: applications must be postmarked by 5 p.m. on March 15 (for the summer semester), July 15 (for the fall semester) and December 15 (for the spring semester).

Vocational Scholarships

Vocational scholarships are for those students who do not meet the criteria for the Basic Scholarship/ Standard Degree Program, but who want to attend a vocational program of study or certification. Students will receive funding equal to the cost of the course, not to exceed \$500, and may receive funding once per year.



How Do I Apply?

To apply for a MTNT scholarship, the following must be submitted by the Scholarship Deadline:

- A completed **application**
- A **student release and consent**
- A **letter of acceptance** from the school he/she will be attending
- **Official transcripts** sent directly from the school
- **Biography** of yourself, why you are attending, proof of Eligibility for Lineal Descendants (include who your grandparents and parents, etc.)

Continuing Students must submit the following by the Scholarship Deadline:

- A completed application
- College transcripts and/or progress reports for vocational students
- Proof of enrollment for each funding period
- Copy of Certificates/Degree upon completion of Program

What is the deadline to submit MTNT scholarship applications?

Applications must be postmarked by 4:00 p.m. on the following dates:

July 15 - Fall Semester
December 15 – Spring Semester
March 15 – Summer Semester
